

Surgical, Medical or Tele-Abortion?

 Timing Performed between 6-17 weeks of pregnancy. Requires a more complex, longer procedure after 14 weeks of pregnancy. 	 Timing Ideally performed between 5-7 weeks of pregnancy.  Process Procedure performed in our operating room. Performed under intravenous sedation (twilight). Pregnancy tissue is gently suctioned from the uterus using a small, plastic tube. Procedure generally takes 10-15 minutes, but you will be in our clinic for a total of approximately 3 hours (including recovery time). You will need to take a dose of antibiotics at home (Clinic 66 will provide the prescription). May only require one clinic visit. 	 Process You visit the clinic and meet with a consultant who will do blood tests and ultrasound. First medication (Mifepristone) taken at the clinic and second medication (Misoprostol) taken at home 24-48 hours later which will induce a miscarriage. Leads to bleeding and cramping (ranging from mild to severe) which can last up to 3 weeks. Follow up visit is required 3 weeks later with repeat ultrasound assessment to ensure the termination is complete. 	 Process You meet with a consultant online who will give you an ultrasound request form, which you will have done locally. You meet with the consultant again to review tests and she will provide you with prescriptions for the medication, which you will source locally. You will conduct the medical abortion at home (per 'Medical' option). one week later you will receive an SMS checking in on your progress. 5 weeks after the procedure, you should do a home pregnancy test to ensure it is negative.
 Support and Recovery It is ideal to have a support person to accompany you to the clinic and take you home after the procedure. You are unable to drive 24 hours after sedation. Afterwards, you will remain in our recovery room with ongoing nursing care until you have fully recovered and are able to go home. 	 Support and Recovery It is highly recommended that you have someone to support you at home for at least the first 24 hours after taking the second set of medications. Clinic 66 doctors can provide you with medications to assist with pain and cramping. 	 Support and Recovery It is highly recommended that you have someone to support you at home for at least the first 24 hours after taking the second set of medications.
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 Side Effects May feel tired/vague for the rest of the day due to the sedation used. May experience bleeding and mild cramping, lasting less than 2 weeks (similar to a period). 	 Side Effects Bleeding and cramping (as described above). Possible nausea and vomiting.  Cost For all patients, the upfront cost is \$990. Patients who hold a valid Medicare card will be able to claim a Medicare benefit, which will be paid electronically into their nominated bank account. Surgical termination of pregnancy beyond 12 weeks has higher fees. Please call 0294113411 to discuss fees for midtrimester abortion 	 Cost For patients on a weekday, with a medicare card: Upfront cost = \$505 If you have a valid medicare card rebates are available, if you do not have a medicare card, please contact Clinic 66 for further information and an accurate quote. 	Cost There are now Medicare rebates available for a Tele-Abortion. The initial consult is a private fee of \$100 (approx. \$82 rebate). The second consultation is a private fee if \$330. (approx. \$82 rebate). After the second consultation, you get the prescription. You pay fees for the medication directly to the local pharmacist. Medication = \$35 (approx.) with Medicare or \$390 (approx.) without. (\$8 with HealthCare card). Ultrasound costs vary. If you have a Medicare card, you may be able to negotiate bulk billing. Pathology tests (blood, urine) can usually be bulk billed if they are required.	
 Complications Complications are rare but may include bleeding, infection and need for further surgery. Our nurses and doctors can provide you with more information about risks and complications. 	 Complications Complications are rare but there is a chance that the medical procedure will be unsuccessful (2 -5%) requiring a surgical procedure. Our nurses and doctors can provide you with more information about risks and complications. 	 Complications Complications are rare but there is a chance that the medical procedure will be unsuccessful (2-5%) requiring a surgical procedure. You must live within 2hrs of a 24hr hospital emergency department to be eligible for Tele-Abortion.
